RESOLUTION

IDENTIFYING 45 CFR PART 1639 AS AN APPROPRIATE SUBJECT FOR RULEMAKING

[Resolution 2001-005]

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court issued a decision on February 28, 2001 in the case of Legal Services Corporation v. Velazquez in which the court struck a portion of the LSC regulation on Welfare Reform found at 45 CFR Part 1639 as unconsitutional; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for LSC to amend the regulation to make it conform to the decision in *Velazquez*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby identifies 45 CFR Part 1639 as an appropriate subject for rulemaking in accordance with the LSC Rulemaking Protocol.
