Anishinabe Legal Services	In 2011, our program had an attorney resign for fear of other staff losing their positions due to funding cuts, and have been unable to fill that position.
Central Minnesota Legal Services	If there are LSC cuts so that overall LSC funding is less in 2012, there may be more staff cuts. Our state is projecting another deficit for the next budget biennium which starts July 1, 2013 in our state.
_	Part of the reduction is due to budget cuts at the state level as well as "trickle down" cuts from various local funders that have seen reductions in income. A significant part of the reduction in the 2nd half of 2012 is from a poverty population adjustment at the state level that works to our disadvantage. We are maintaining staffing levels in 2012 by using up a portion of our reserve funding. Unless funding improves in 2013, we anticipate laying off 4 to 6 staff at the end of 2013.
Legal Services of Northwest Minnesota	In the past nine months our program has closed a regional office and lost 20 percent of our staff. Cuts are in nearly all funding sources. The cuts have decimated our program due to across the board cuts at one time. The consequences to our poor clients and their children are worse.
